We at Harrogate Spring Water are preparing to update the Reserved Matters planning application to extend our headquarters off Harlow Moor Road. Following community feedback, we have entered into an agreement to purchase adjoining land, if planning permission is approved, on which new publicly accessible woodland would be created as part of our commitment to replace the woodland impacted by the development.

This additional land, together with improved on-site landscaping, will mean that the development proposals will now see approximately 1,500 new trees planted on and adjacent to our headquarters.

THE PROPOSALS

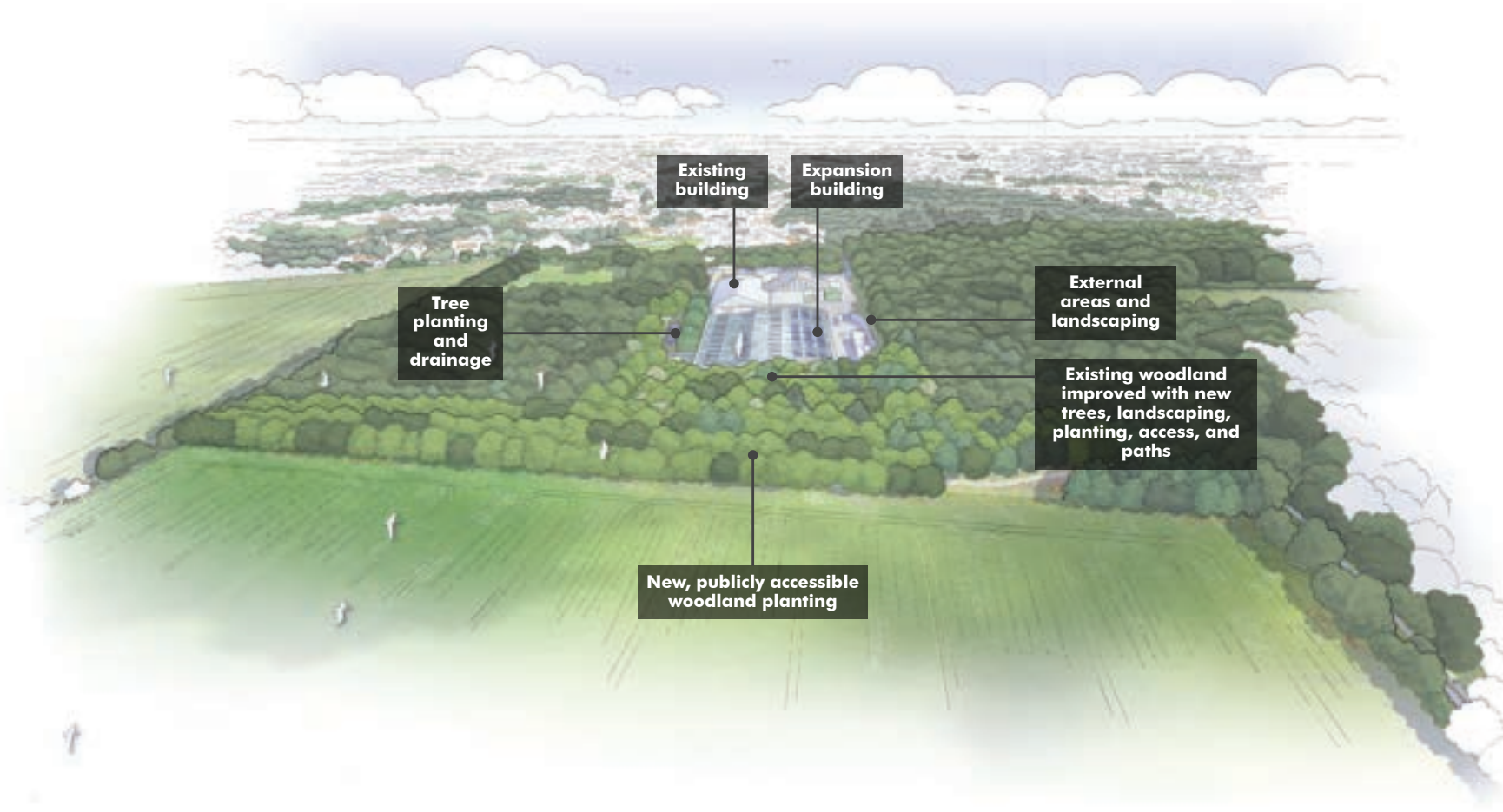
New, publicly accessible community woodland with around 1,500 trees planted on land within and adjoining our headquarters
